5. Hanging system was discussed. Prue had done research on the pricing of the AVANTI system which has bee installed in one room of the railway, by the builders. If the space is approximately 58 mteres of track to cover the other exhibition spaces it would cost

Geoff wanted to know what the committee thought about an exhibition of Curly after the opening of the Railway arts hub in September. We discussed the possibility of the exhibition of Photography to be installed in October / November. There was concern voiced about feeling that the sub committee was formed for the opening and not for the long term.

The arts programing committee has yet to be established, the vision and the master plan not being in place, and the nuts and bolts of costing's and materials needed in a practical sense to put exhibitions up. The committee felt safer to plan for 2016, however, it was reported that the family of Curly feel that the photographs are framed and ready to hang and so Andrew was going to talk to Geoff, who would talk to the family, about the practicalities of installing and manning the exhibition as a family project in the memory of Curly. If they could cover this responsibility, it would sit better. More discussion is needed at the next meeting on Monday 29th June at the Committee meeting.
